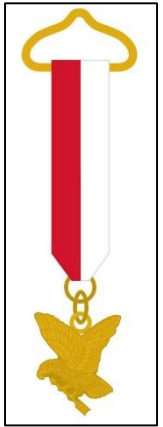




# Nentico Centennial Award

The **NCA** is a reproduction of the original Nentico Lodge totem pin suspended from a pocket ribbon to be worn from the right uniform pocket to signify your achievement. The award will help you meet new friends, find new interests and help you get a head start on the path of service that is the hallmark of **the Order of the Arrow and Nentico Lodge 12**. Requirements may be completed from June 30, 2021 to December 31, 2022. (\*Note, a nine month extension to September - 2023 may be granted to members inducted in August & September 2022.)

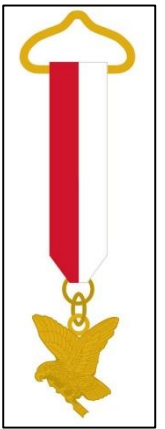
